ABGs

60 yrs old smoker lady presented with dyspnea shortness of breath , crackles on the base of her lung by auscultation

ABG Ph 7,36

Pa co2 35

Po2 55

Hco3 24

Everything else is normal

It was confusing because normal ABG with hypoxemia : respiratory failure type 1

Interstitial lung fibrosis (fibrosing alveolitis)

The questions : comment on this ABG

What is the diagnosis of ABG >> respiratory failure type 1

What is the respiratory function pattern of this disorder ? restrictive

What are the RFT changes ?

What is the final diagnosis

ECG : inferior wall MI complicated with hypotension (the same as the previous years)

Iron deficiency anemia

It was celiac disease and the rash was dermatitis herpetiformis (no picture but the patient was complaining of chronic diarrhea and bloating and itchy rash on the legs)

Dynamic :

GERD

Hepatitis B communication

Cushing syndrome (pt with SLE , lupus nephritis , on steroids)

Cardio pt with VSD (diffuse pan systolic murmur ,+ ejection systolic on the pulmonary area (pulmonary stenosis)) the pt has tetralogy of fallot

Respiratory ; pleural effusion
