

Miss fatma marwan Jaber 32 years old female patient married, and has 3 daughter, 2 sons, she lives in ashatea camp, she is a housewife, she was admitted to the endoscopic department via ER on 11 oct ,10 am...

no history of smoking or alcohol abuse..

the history was taken from the pt herself and she was cooperative with me..

CC She complains from abdominal pain for 3 months..

She was in the usual state of health till 3 month before admission..

HPI The condition starts with gradual moderate ^{colic} epigastric ~~abdominal~~ pain, continuous and progressive course, not radiating to other area, exacerbated by lifting heavy items and relieved by ^{أسبرين} Aspir associated with heart burn, watery diarrhea for 2 days ago, about 4 times daily and wake her from sleeping, she has nausea without vomiting, she has anorexia, weight loss about 5 Kg at last 3 mon. she has abdominal ^{تورم في البطن} distention 2 years ago, itching especially at LL. and has bilateral LL edema. no fever, no night sweats, no dysphagia or odynophagia, no constipation.

PMH this is the first time hospitalized and doesn't have any chronic diseases [DM, HTN, asthma, CKD..]

→ No previous similar attack..

OSH CS for 1 time before 2 years and had bleeding after the operation so they give her one unit of blood... no complication

DH analgesic capsule green and yellow when she complains of headache, LL edema.
↳ twice daily (1x2). no allergy or OTC.

she drink ^{كافيين} Aspir, ^{كافيين} Caffeine

no illicit drugs

No drug or food allergy

No history of vaccination..

FH her mother die from breast cancer. ^{عائلة عربية}

her father has HTN.

there is 1st degree relative consanguinity.

SH She lives in the 2nd floor, poor ventilation, poor financial status, she has medical insurance, no animal contact, no travel history...

ROS CNS:- headache relieved by analgesia, no dizziness. ^{في أي جانب واحد} ^{bilateral or not.}

MSS:- myalgia, arthralgia [morning stiffness for 15 min], no joint swelling.

cardiac:- palpitation, bilateral LL edema relieved temporarily by analgesia, no orthopnea, no PND

resp:- no cough, no sputum, no haemoptysis, no dyspnea or PND or orthopnea, no chest pain, no wheeze

reproductive:- regular menstrual cycle, heavy amount of 6 day of bleeding, no breast abnormality, no history of abortion.

hematology:- no easy bleeding, normal injury healing, no pallor
